

Respecting the Property

We kindly ask you to respect this historic site by not leaning against walls or the collection and refraining from sitting on or touching the collection during your visit. Our 275 staff members are almost all volunteers who strive to make your visit as pleasant as possible. In their spare time, they ensure Kasteel Amerongen is preserved and remains open for future generations.

- **Follow Staff Instructions:** Always follow instructions from castle staff and security personnel.
- **Treat Assets with Care:** Protect and treat castle assets, equipment, and the building itself with care, according to regulations.
- **Do Not Touch Artifacts:** Avoid touching historical objects to prevent damage.
- **Prohibited Items and Activities**
 - **Food and Drink:** Do not bring food or drinks into the museum areas.
 - **Bags and Backpacks:** All bags, backpacks, and umbrellas are not allowed inside and must be stored in designated cloakrooms or lockers.
 - **Wheelchairs, walkers, prams, and pushchairs** are not allowed inside the castle to avoid damage to the collection. These can be left in the basement (at your own risk). Baby carriers are also not permitted.
 - **Only shoes and walking sticks** that do not damage the floors are allowed inside the castle (high heels, cycling shoes, or studded shoes are not permitted).
 - **Smoking:** Prohibited on the whole estate
- **Photography Guidelines**
 - **Private Use Only:** Photography is typically for personal use, not for commercial or professional purposes.
 - **Flash and Tripods:** Using flash is not allowed due to the fragility of collections.
 - **Drones and Professional Equipment:** Drones, tripods, professional cameras, and selfie sticks are not allowed for photography.
 - **Respect Others:** Be considerate of other visitors when taking photos.
- **Behavior and Etiquette**
 - **No Noise:** Avoid excessive noise to maintain tranquility and respect other visitors.
 - **Keep Areas Tidy:** Dispose of your litter in provided trash cans.
 - **No Climbing:** Do not climb on rocks or walls.
 - **Parents/guardians** are responsible for, and accountable for, their children's behaviour
- **Other Rules**
 - **Pets:** Only assistance or guide dogs are typically allowed; other pets are not.
 - **Bikes:** Only assistance bikes are typically allowed; other bikes are not.
 - **Entry Risk:** Entering the castle and grounds is at your own risk.
 - **Consequences:** Failure to comply with house rules may result in being asked to leave the premises.
